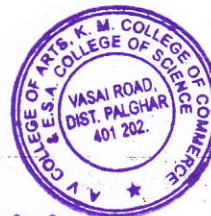
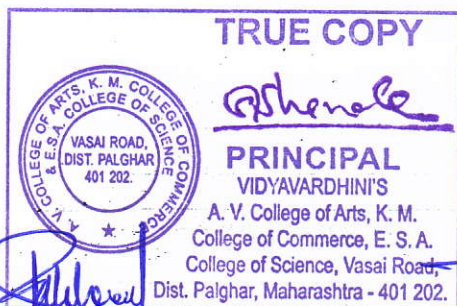

6. Admission, preparations of teaching programme and payment of remuneration to recognized post-graduate teachers engage in teaching programme is the responsibility of the college.

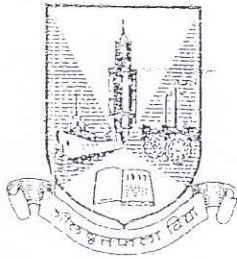
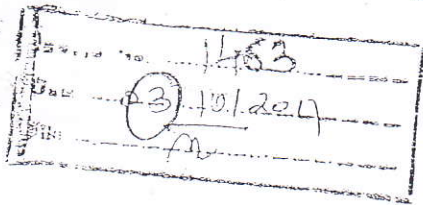

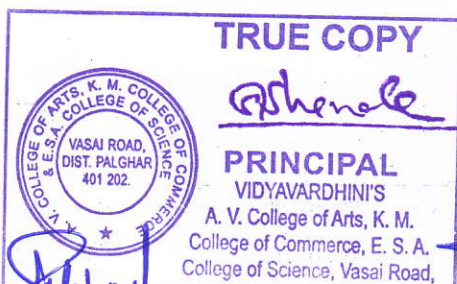
