



Unity in diversity is a prominent feature of Indian society. Considering the world, minorities are classified on various basis linguistic, religious, ethnic etc.

The Indian Constitution has given everyone educational and cultural rights to all the citizens and constitutional safeguards to preserve their religious, cultural and linguistic rights. The United Nations adopted and presented the Declaration on the Rights of National, Religious and Linguistic Minorities on 18 December 1992 and according to it, minority citizens have the right to preserve their language, religion, culture and tradition. The reorganisation of the states in India has taken place based on language. Language is an essential part of the culture.

Through this lecture, efforts are made to enable the minorities to express their characteristics effectively. Nowadays, multiculturalism is being given more importance in the world. Efforts should be made to preserve the rights and identity of minorities. The program emphasized the discussion of these various things.

Dr Anil Kumar Shelke, Vice-Dr. of the college chaired the session and delivered an introductory speech. The discussion was initiated by Prof. Nitin Kumar Bangar (the head of the Department of Political Science), elaborated by Prof. Dr Suresh Surve, and ended with a vote of thanks from Prof. Dattatraya Tonde.

6 VIOLATION OF RIGHTS OF MINORITIES,  
It must be noted here that the Constitution does not define the term "minorities".  
However, it provides for some rights of religious and linguistic minorities. Not all minorities suffer from violation of rights.  
Moreover, minorities do not suffer from all forms of violation of rights.

7 Among the religious minorities, Muslims constitute the largest group, comprising more than 13 per cent of the total population. Muslims suffer the most from lack of economic and social development, due to several reasons. Other religious minorities are in a much better socio-economic condition. Following points summarily show the problems faced by Muslims:

8 a) Worker population ratio was lower in Muslims due to lower participation of women in economic activities.  
b) Unemployment rate is higher in Muslims than in other communities.  
c) In asset ownership, Muslims are the most disadvantaged.  
d) One-third of the Muslims are below  
e) Only one-third of Muslim women have institutional deliveries.  
f) Literacy rate is lowest in Muslims compared to other religious communities  
g) Enrolment of Muslim girls at the primary and upper primary levels is below 50 per cent poverty line.  
h) There is a high percentage in Muslims of out of school children. One major violation of rights of linguistic minorities is the neglect of their need to provide education to their children in their own mother tongue. Although it is the Constitutional duty of the State governments to create educational facilities at the primary level for linguistic minorities, many States do not take the responsibility seriously.
