

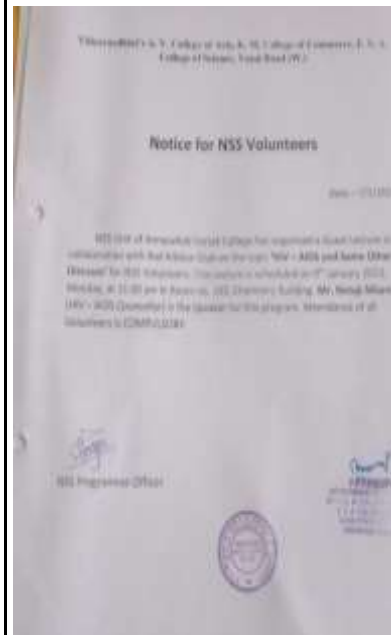
**3.4.1 - Extension activities are carried out in the neighbourhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and the impact thereof during the year 2022-23.**

**Aids Awareness** was observed in Annasaheb Vartak College on account of World AIDS Day. on the occasion of this, the **Unit of NSS** organized a special lecture by Mr. Netaji Nikam (ICTC Counsellor MSACS, Government Hospital Virar) guided volunteers on the seriousness of this issue and awareness of AIDS. She also insisted on the ethical and moral behaviour of human beings with special reference to youth. 79 volunteers participated in this program. **The blood Donation camp** was held in Vartak College with the cooperation of Nair Hospital. This camp was held to make volunteers aware of blood donation we got a huge response we did collect 82 blood units. 42 volunteers participated in this program. NSS Volunteers organized an **exhibition and selling of eco-friendly rakhis** of bamboo and fruit seeds made by **tribal women of Palghar District**. 150 rakhis were sold and the money was transferred to Seva Vivek Center, Bhalivali who handed it over to tribal women. It Created awareness in people about using eco-friendly products to conserve the environment and help tribal people. A total of 30 NSS Volunteers participated in this activity. NSS volunteers collected plastic in Vasai Fort and organized a **cleanliness drive** in Vasai Fort. A total of 96 NSS Volunteers participated in this activity. Dr. Suresh Surve (Assistant Professor in Political Science) delivered a lecture on the topic '**Rights of Consumer**. A total of 79 NSS Volunteers participated in this activity.

The objective of this activity is to promote Plastic Free Society and Sustainable Measures of Development. It is based on the principle of **Reduce, Recycle and Reuse**. NSS Volunteers Collected waste newspapers from nearby people They made more than 3000 bags of these waste newspapers and then, they distributed these paper bags to 200 street vendors in Vasai–Virar in January with a request 'not to use plastic bags. This campaign will help to promote the identity of Vasai which is 'Harit Vasai, Sundar Vasai'. NSS volunteers distributed paper bags made by them out of waste newspapers to nearly 200 street vendors in Vasai–Virar in January with a request 'not to use plastic bags.' This campaign will help to promote the identity of Vasai which is 'Harit Vasai, Sundar Vasai. A total of 64 NSS Volunteers participated in this activity (Beneficiaries – 200 street vendors)

On the occasion of Valentine's Day, NSS volunteers **distributed 400 lunch parcel packets to children and senior citizens** living on the street and in slums as a token of love and affection. This is a college-level activity started by NSS volunteers in 2017 with the initiative of the NSS Leader of that year Mr. Kishan Sahani wherein teachers and ex-students contribute money. Ex-NSS volunteers and current NSS volunteers collaboratively prepare food and engage in the packaging of food parcels and their distribution to the needy. A total of 34 NSS Volunteers participated in this activity.

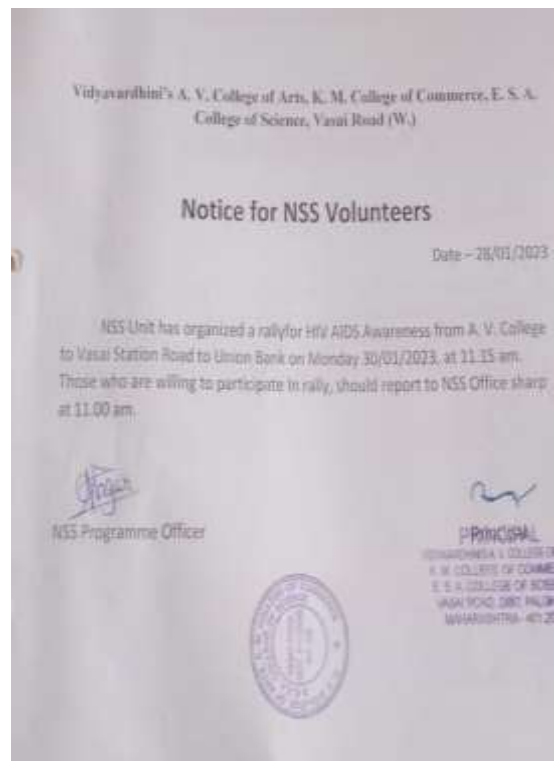

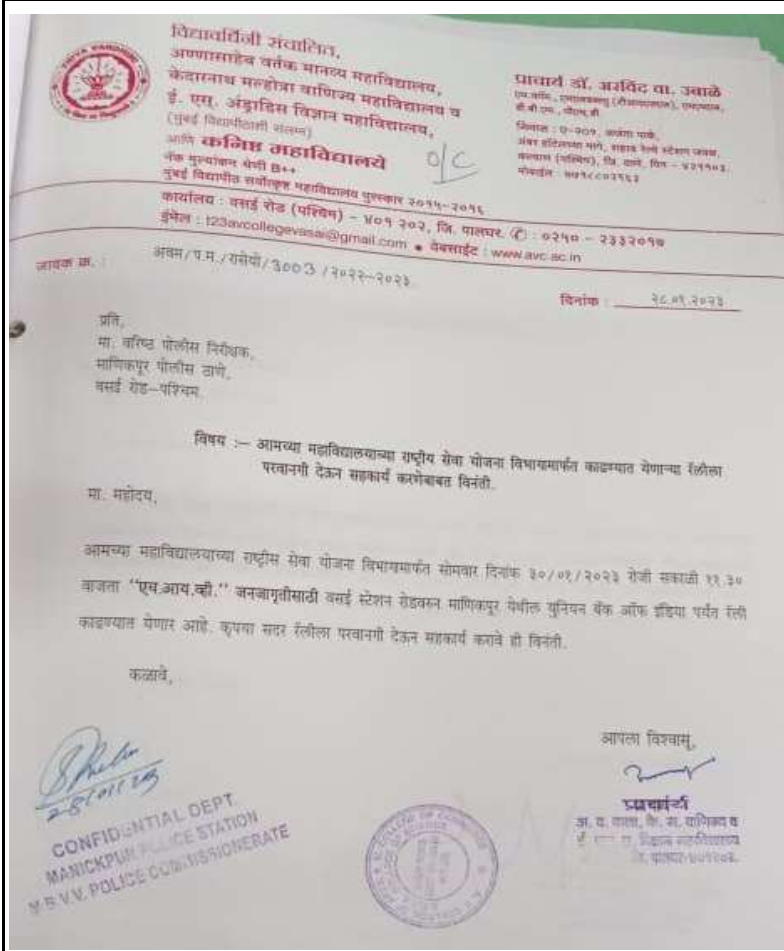
- To create awareness about causes and preventive measures of HIV AIDS in the residential societies in Vasai - Virar.

### **Purpose –**

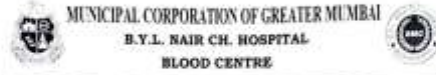

- They distributed it to street vendors in the Vasai-Virar area to promote ‘Green Vasai, Beautiful Vasai’ Campaign and support the movement of a plastic free society.
